As a father of three, Dr. Shanahan has personal experience working with kids! He knows the challenges of balancing busy schedules and getting great results in time for important events like graduation or a special birthday. Technology is making appointments shorter and more comfortable. Remember the goopy stuff you had to have in your mouth to take an impression of your teeth? Not anymore! The process now includes using a small digital scanner to create a 3D model

that can then be printed on a 3D printer in order to make aligners, retainers, or custom-made braces. "We use state of the art technology. We were the first orthodontic office in Napa to get a digital 3D x-ray machine to use for complex cases. Back when I was a resident at UCSF, I studied the use of such technology as part of my master's thesis in virtual treatment of complex cases. When I work up a treatment plan for each individual, I review all the data and each image in detail." It's that attention to detail that has led Dr. Shanahan to discover potential medical issues. "I have been able to catch early diagnoses of cancer, clogged or hardened arteries, among others." It's pretty amazing to see the level of detail that goes into reviewing and creating a custom-made treatment plan for each and every patient. That's why we get patients from all over the world, not just here in Napa. They trust our office to take care of them and Dr. Shanahan takes that trust very seriously.

Ask any member of Dr. Shanahan's team and they will tell you the top priority is doing what is right for the patient. It's not about the bottom line. "I'm a healthcare provider, not a salesman. We don't nickel and dime families, and we don't sell extra treatment that people don't need. It's important to be aware of advertisements for things that seem too good to be true. In today's market, there are so many ads offering big discounts, unrealistically short treatment times, or even at-home DIY orthodontics. Anyone considering orthodontic care should trust their dentist to make a good referral. In Napa, we are very fortunate to have many excellent dentists. As an orthodontist, I'm in a unique position to get to know the local dentists well and see the results of their work. I am so thankful to be working in such a wonderful dental community and for the opportunity to work with such great people and in many cases be entrusted to not only treat their patients, but also their families or themselves."
